EXPLANATORY NOTE


Bridges, like roads, serve as links of production centers & farms to trade centers or markets. Thus, bridges in rural areas encourage the growth of trade and commerce activities which benefit rural folks. Such infrastructure also provide conducive condition for greater mobility of people whether for economic or other purposes.

This is the case with the Bagbag Bridge of Solsona town in the province of Ilocos Norte.

Due to the havoc and devastation wrought by Typhoon Maring last 14 September 1992 halted temporarily such mobility and economic activities. This is further aggravated by the destruction of the Bagbag Bridge which is very vital to ^{the} town's trade and commercial ventures.

In line with the above pertinent considerations, this bill seeks the restoration of approach fill and stone masonry protection with sausage apron instead of riprap to the Bagbag Bridge located in the Municipality of Solsona Ilocos Norte.

Considering the inadequacy of Ilocos Norte's local government funds to immediately repair and rehabilitate the Bagbag Bridge, assistance from the National Government is earnestly requested by the way of approval of this bill.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE RESTORATION OF APPROACH FILL AND STONE MASONRY PROTECTION WITH SAUSAGE APRON TO THE BAGBAG BRIDGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall undertake the restoration of approach fill and stone masonry protection with sausage apron instead of riprap to the Bagbag Bridge located in the Municipality of Solsona, Province of Ilocos Norte.

SEC. 2. The sum of P 253,000.00 or such sum as may be necessary for the implementation of this Act is hereby charged to the appropriations of the Department of Public Works and Highways under the current General Appropriations Act. Hereafter, such sum as may be necessary for its maintenance shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
