EXPLANATORY NOTE

It is the policy of the state to provide affordable quality secondary education to the country's youth. This policy of the government has been translated into tangible program through the establishment of national high schools in rural areas.

An agro-industrial national high school in Esclita, Ilocos Norte, would furnish quality secondary education to the youth of the area. The said school will be hitting two birds in one stone. First, it will provide the youth with ordinary high school education, then equip them with agro-industrial skills and technology necessary in immediate job placement in the instance of non-continuance to tertiary education which has, now, become unaffordable to many.

Approval of this bill which seeks to establish an agro-industrial high school in Esclita, Ilocos Norte, is thus earnestly requested.

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AGRO-INDUSTRIAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ESPIRITU, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS NORTE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

Section 1. There shall be established and maintained under the supervision of the Bureau of Technical and Vocational Education of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), Department of Agriculture (DA), and the Technology and Livelihood Resource Center of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) an agro-industrial high school in the Municipality of Espiritu, Province of Ilocos Norte.

Section 2. The DECS, DA, and DTI are directed to take the necessary steps to implement this Act.

Section 3. The amount needed for the enrollment, operation and maintenance of said vocational school shall be sourced from the current appropriations of DECS, DA, and DTI as provided for in the General Appropriations Act (GAA). Thereafter, the amount needed for its operations and maintenance shall be included in the annual GAA.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
