RESOLUTION

ENDING THE FILIPINO YOUTH FOR ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING
IN THE FIRST SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS AND
CONGRATULATING ALL THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE
BEEN ELECTED INTO OFFICE

WHEREAS, the first Sangguniang Kabataan(SK) election held throughout the country on December 4,1992 and in Iloilo, Manila and Bulacan on December 15,1992;

WHEREAS, there were from 8 Million to 10 Million of Filipino youth who registered for the SK elections of chairmen and members of the barangay youth council;

WHEREAS, at least 75% of the registered youth voters actually cast their votes on the aforesaid election dates;

WHEREAS, moreover, the latest report of the Department of Interior and Local Government - the implementing agency which was principally tasked to oversee SK elections-state that said elections were generally peaceful and orderly, except for the reported interference of some unscrupulous officials;

WHEREAS, the enthusiasm manifested by the youth and the loyalty they showed in the conduct of said elections augur well for their early introduction to participatory democracy;

WHEREAS, the Filipino youth deserves, therefore, to be commended for their active participation in the justly conducted SK elections and all candidates who have been elected into office equally deserve the country's heartfelt congratulations for giving themselves up to public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby enacted, to commend the Filipino youth for actively participating in the first Sangguniang Kabataan elections and congratulate all candidates who have been elected into
